3. Submit the form and check to Lindsay Oil Company Inc by mail to PO Box 381, Pickens, SC 29671-0381 or bring them into our Pickens or Seneca Office to Attention of Office Manager.

How does BDA work?

- The Bank Draft Authorization (BDA) program permits Lindsay Oil Company Inc to electronically deduct money from your bank, savings and loan, or credit union checking account to pay your invoices.
- You will receive a draft notice indicating the BDA payment date and amount.
- If you should need to temporarily suspend the transfer, simply contact Lindsay Oil Company's Office manager at 864-878-9388 four working days prior to the due date on your bill. You can then pay by cash or check.
